

Introduction: Per our By-Laws, DAEC annually conducts an election to select the next class, 2 Men & 2 Women, to serve the community for a 3-year term starting January 1st. Nominees are members of the community who meet the qualifications and are prepared to fulfill the expectations listed below.

Election Process: Ballots will be published 30 days in advance. Members may cast ballots in advance via e-mail.

The ballot count shall be certified by the Spiritual Director, Community Lay Director, and Secretary and ratified by the Members at a brief community meeting to be held at the next community gathering.

Board Member Qualifications:

1. Active in a Reunion Group
2. Served two or more times in the Conference Room
3. Able to serve a 3-year term (2019, 2020, 2021)

Board Member Expectations:

1. A Board Member is a 3-year service commitment.
2. The roles on the board typically rotate, but can remain the same. Many times this has to do with the spiritual gifts of the members and preference. Descriptions can be requested from any existing board member.
3. As a board member serving on a team is typically limited to being a board rep for walks
4. Meetings are typically the second Tuesday of each month (per the By-Laws) at a location of the boards choosing
5. Participation in Walk Orientations, Gatherings, and Commissioning which is about 4-8 total events a year.
6. Depending on position/duties, attending walks for Send-off, Candlelight, and Closing is recommended and at times assisting in service may be requested.
