



AGAPE CHAIR

As a member of the Board of Directors of the Denton Area Emmaus Community the Agape Chair is responsible for sending of agape letters to and the receiving of agape letters from other Walk to Emmaus and similar 3-day communities world-wide, and guiding the local Community with agape questions and suggestions. The Agape Chair also manages the book list for each walk weekend.

Responsibilities:

- Provide agape letters (also called general agape and wall agape)) for communities world-wide via email.
- Solicit agape letters from communities world-wide via email and through Upper Room website.
- Print and make wall agape available for each walk.
- Provide guidance and suggestions to DAEC members on providing table and bed agape for weekend walks.
- Work with the Literature Chair and weekend Board Representative on obtaining and making sure the books for sale to pilgrims on each walk are purchased, inventoried, and on-site.

Characteristics:

- Strong organizational skills.
- Computer competence in use of the Internet, e-mail, and word processing software.
- Good record keeping skills.
- Abundant patience.
