



All DAEC Board Positions

Member of the Board of Directors of the Denton Area Emmaus Community act in support roles to the Emmaus Community as described in the Upper Room publication "Coordinators' Manual." Support roles may vary among Communities depending upon local logistics and need; for example, DAEC walks are currently held at a facility that provides full room and board, so kitchen and housing chairs are not needed in our community. DAEC has written position descriptions (including this one) for our active chairs and committees that are fully available to the Community at dentonemmaus.org.

Responsibilities for all Board members include:

1. Regularly attends board meetings and important related meetings, workshops, training events, team orientation, gatherings, etc.
2. Makes a serious commitment to participate actively in Board and any assigned committee work.
3. Volunteers for and willingly accepts assignments and completes them thoroughly and on time.
4. Stays informed about committee matters, prepares themselves well for meetings, and reviews and comments on minutes and reports.
5. Gets to know other committee members and builds a collegial working relationship that contributes to consensus.
6. Is an active participant in the committee's annual evaluation and planning efforts.
7. Participates in marketing the Walk to Emmaus, recruiting both pilgrims and team members.
8. Commits to the covenant with the Upper Room.
